# COUNCIL

# **REPORTS**

Secretary Hossain, Chair of the Council, took roll call. He introduced himself as chair and gave some opening remarks. He thanked the members of Council and took particular note of a quote from the Executive Order – the Governor "wants us to create an action plan to address any gaps in access, affordability, or delivery of services with the goal of removing silos across state agencies, healthcare providers, payers, state and local government sectors and decrease wait time for services for Pennsylvania." He reiterated his commitment to that goal and how all of the Council has been brought together to achieve that goal.

Secretary Hossain then yielded the floor to Secretary Arkoosh, who also gave brief introductory remarks. She welcomed the Council to the first meeting. She cited the actionable work with the Council has been tasked and how each of the Council members has a responsibility to collaborate to meet the behavioral health needs of Pennsylvanians.

Secretary Hossain yielded the floor to Dr. Finello, who gave some introductory remarks about how the Council is a call to action to help the people who need it the most. She then introduced three speakers who each spoke about their lived experience. Those members were Robert Hamilton, Kate Favata, and Jennifer Wilt.

Dr. Finello then presented slides about the current behavioral health landscape in Pennsylvania. She then reviewed the results of a survey that had over 900 responses.

Secretary Hossain ended the meeting with some closing remarks where we thanked the Council members for their time and reiterated the challenging task ahead but noted the Governor's full force behind the work.
